- A Bachelor's degree in Veterinary Science/Veterinary Science and Animal Husbandry/Dairy Science/Dairy Technology/Fisheries Science of respective discipline from SAU/ SVU/ Deemed University or any other recognized university.
- 2. A Master's degree with a minimum of 55% marks (50% marks for SC/ST) (or an equivalent grade in a point-scale wherever the grading system is followed) in a concerned /Allied subject from SAU/SVU/Deemed University or any other recognized University, or an equivalent degree from an accredited foreign University.
- 3. The candidate must have cleared the NET conducted by the UGC/ICAR/CSIR, or a similar test accredited by the UGC, like SLET/SET or who are or have been awarded a Ph.D Degree in accordance with the University Grants Commission (Minimum Standards and Procedure for award of M.Phill./Ph.D Degree) Regulations, 2009 or 2016 and their amendments from time to time as the case may be exempted from NET/SLET/SET.
