Professor (Pay Scale Rs. 144200-218200)

Qualifications and Guidelines:

1. A Bachelor's degree in Veterinary Science/Veterinary Science and Animal Husbandry the concerned discipline from SAU/ SVU/Deemed University or any other recognized university.
2. A Master's degree with at least 55% marks (50% for SC/ST) or an equivalent grade in a point-scale, wherever the grading system is followed in concerned /allied subject from SAU/SVU/Deemed University or any other recognized university.
3. An eminent scholar having a Ph.D degree in the concerned / Allied discipline, and published work of high quality, actively engaged in research with evidence of published work with a minimum of 10 research publications in the NAAS rated / UGC listed journals.

4. A minimum of 10 years of Teaching / Research / Extension experience in University / College as Assistant Professor / Associate Professor and / or research experience at equivalent level at the University/ National Level Institutions with evidence of having successfully guided doctoral candidate/Master degree candidate, out of which **two years of service / experience in the cadre of Associate Professor** in the pay band Rs.**1,31,400-2,17,100** as applicable to Associate Professor or equivalent positions of ICAR/UGC shall be mandatory.
5. Knowledge of Kannada is Mandatory:
Note : If candidate did not studied Kannada as a first or second or third language in S.S.L.C or its equivalent qualification, then the candidate shall be eligible for interview in respect of Professor post only if He/She qualifies in a test in Kannada language. This test shall comprise of one paper carrying a maximum of 150 marks. For qualifying in this paper, a candidate must secure a minimum of 50% marks. The standard of this paper shall be that of first language Kannada at S.S.L.C level.
6. A minimum score as stipulated in the score card.

Associate Professor (pay scale Rs 1,31,400 - 2,17,100)

Qualifications and Guidelines:

1. A Bachelor's degree in Veterinary Science/Veterinary Science and Animal Husbandry of respective discipline from SAU/ SVU/Deemed University or any other recognized university.
2. A Master's degree with at least 55% marks (50% marks for SC/ST) or an equivalent grade in a point-scale, wherever the grading system is followed in concerned /allied subject from SAU/SVU/Deemed University or any other recognized university.
3. A good academic record, with a Ph.D degree in the concerned/Allied discipline
4. A minimum of eight years of teaching experience and / or research and / or extension in an academic / research position equivalent to that of Assistant Professor in a University, College, or Accredited Research Institution in a pay band Rs.**57,700 – 1,82,400** as applicable to Assistant Professor or equivalent cadres of ICAR/ UGC with a minimum of **Seven publications** in NAAS rated / UGC listed Journals.
5. Knowledge of Kannada is mandatory:
Note: If candidate did not studied Kannada as a first or second or third language in S.S.L.C or its equivalent qualification, then the candidate shall be eligible for interview in respect of Associate Professor post only if He/She qualifies in a test in Kannada language. This test shall comprise of one paper carrying a maximum of 150 marks. For qualifying in this paper, a candidate must secure a minimum of 50% marks. The standard of this paper shall be that of first language Kannada at S.S.L.C level.
6. A minimum score as stipulated in the prescribed score card.

Assistant Professor (Pay Scale Rs. 57,700 – 1,82,400)

Qualifications and Guidelines:

1. A Bachelor's degree in Veterinary Science/Veterinary Science and Animal Husbandry of respective discipline from SAU/ SVU/ Deemed University or any other recognized university.
2. A Master's degree with a minimum of 55% marks (50% marks for SC/ST) (or an equivalent grade in a point-scale wherever the grading system is followed) in a concerned /Allied subject from SAU/SVU/Deemed University or any other recognized University, or an equivalent degree from an accredited foreign University.
3. The candidate must have cleared the NET conducted by the UGC/ICAR/CSIR, or a similar test accredited by the UGC, like SLET/SET or who are or have been awarded a Ph.D Degree in accordance with the **University Grants Commission** (Minimum Standards and Procedure for award of M. Phil./Ph.D. Degree) **Regulations, 2009 or 2016** and their amendments from time to time as the case may be exempted from NET/SLET/SET.
4. NET is exempted for such Master's degree programmes where NET is not conducted by ICAR/UGC/CSIR/SLET/SET in the concerned / Allied subjects.
5. NET is also exempted for those who obtained Ph.D degree from a foreign University / Institution with a ranking among top 500 in the world University Ranking. However, such candidate has to fulfill the conditions given below as per the Government Order No. AHF113 VET 2018/Bangalore dated 16.3.2019.
6. Provided, the candidates registered for the Ph.D, Program prior to July 11th 2009, shall be governed by the provisions of the then existing regulations of the institution awarding the degree and such PhD Candidates shall be exempted from the requirement of NET/SLET/SET for recruitment and appointment of Assistant Professor or equivalent positions in Universities/Colleges/Institutions subject to the fulfillment of the following conditions.
 - a) The Ph.D degree of the candidate has been awarded in a regular mode
 - b) The Ph.D thesis has been evaluated by at least two external examiners.
 - c) The Ph.D viva voce of the candidate has been conducted
 - d) The candidate has published **two research papers** from his/her Ph.D work, out of which at least one is in a referred journal
 - e) The candidate has presented at least **two papers** based on his/her Ph.D work in conferences/seminars sponsored by the UGC/ICAR/ICSSR/CSIR or any other similar agency.

Note: The fulfillment of these conditions is to be certified by the **Registrar** or the **Dean** of University concerned is **mandatory** otherwise candidates will not be eligible for NET exemption.

7. Knowledge of Kannada is mandatory:

Note : **If candidate did not studied Kannada as a first or second or third language in S.S.L.C or its equivalent qualification**, then the candidate shall be eligible for interview in respect of Assistant Professor post only if He/She qualifies in a test in Kannada language. This test shall comprise of one paper carrying a maximum of 150 marks. For qualifying in this paper, a candidate must secure a minimum of 50% marks. The standard of this paper shall be that of first language Kannada at S.S.L.C level.

Age Limit: The candidates should have not crossed **35 years** of age in case of **General Merit**, **38 years** of age in case of **OBC** and **40 years** in case of **SC, ST and Cat-I** category candidates as on the last date of submission of application.

Age relaxation for in-services candidates will be considered based on the order of the Govt. of Karnataka in vogue.

General Instructions to the Candidates:

1. The Short listing of the candidates shall be governed based on Academic and Research score as prescribed under Appendix-1-3 as per guidelines of KVAFSU available on KVAFSU website.
2. Online mode of submission of applications shall be essential. Candidates are advised to satisfy themselves before applying that they possess at least the minimum essential qualifications laid down in the advertisement.
3. Applicants shall first register on the Recruitment portal on the KVAFSU website, after which, they can fill up the prescribed online application form.
4. Separate applications shall be submitted for different positions.
5. Before starting to fill up the form, please ensure that you have the following: A scanned copy of photograph, signature, caste/tribe/community certificate (if any), educational qualifications and experience related documents in JPEG/JPG/PDF format, digital copies of publications for uploading. The photograph other documents should not exceed 500 kb each.
6. While filling the online application, if the browser closes unexpectedly or if the candidate is logged out, he/she may use the login information sent to his/her email to login again.
7. Please ensure to enter all your research publications and other Academic/Research contributions in the online application. Only the **information entered in the online applications form will be considered for deciding eligibility and/or short listing.** Filling all mandatory fields is required to make your application complete. Uploading Scanned copies of publications is not mandatory; however, candidates shall produce the same during physical document verification.
8. Incomplete applications will not be considered and will be **REJECTED**.
9. There are several Tabs in your application. After completing each tab, you should click on **“Save”** button to save the information and move to the next tab. After filling all tabs, the candidate can finally submit his/her application. **Please note that you cannot make any changes after submitting the application form.**

11. On successful submission, the applicant will come across a link for paying application fee and after the Payment the candidate may download a PDF of the application, which he/she will have to print and Submit to KVAFSU after signing it and having it forwarded by his/her employer,
12. Mere eligibility will not entitle any candidate for being called for interview. Applicants having higher qualification and merit will be given preference. Good Academic Record for all teaching positions shall be as defined in the KVAFSU Score Card.
13. Candidates belonging to SCs/STs/OBCs category should submit proper caste/tribe/community certificate as per the proforma prescribed by Government of Karnataka.
14. In service Candidates who claim reservation under **OBC (2A, 2B, 3A, 3B)**, should compulsorily attach the caste certificate and their claim should be as per Govt. Order No. **DPAR 21 SBC 85, Bangalore dated 19th September 1985.**
15. Candidates belonging to 371(j) with category should submit proper certificate with **RD Number** as per the proforma prescribed by Government of Karnataka is **mandatory**.
16. Those who claim reservation **under 371(j)** and/or **Rural quota** (Form-1 & 2) should compulsorily enclose certificate issued by the competent authority in the prescribed

format only. Only 371J certificates issued by competent authority along with RD Number shall be uploaded.

17. Any corrigendum/ changes/ updates related to the recruitment process shall be available on official website of the University www.kvafsu.edu.in only.
18. The candidates can download application form from the official website www.kvafsu.edu.in and after paying the processing **fees of Rs.1000.00 for SC/ST/Cat-I Rs.500.00** online Payment in favour of The Comptroller, KVAFSU, Bidar within the prescribed period of notification
19. The applications which do not accompany the prescribed fees and Incomplete application forms are liable to be rejected.
20. Separate application along with registration fee must be submitted for each of the Post applied.
21. For all the information furnished / claims made, sufficient and appropriate evidence from competent authority should be enclosed.
22. Physically challenged persons should furnish the Medical Certificate from District Medical Board / appropriate authority along with the application.
23. In case the differently abled notified category is not available, the other category candidates will also be considered among the differently abled.
24. Candidates should possess and upload a valid registration of KVC/VCI for the posts under Veterinary faculty (both side in the expiry date in mentioned on back side). **Signature** and the **Expiry date** must be clearly visible, incomplete/poor visibility of any sought the application will be **REJECTED**.
25. Educational qualifications for the period of studies should be indicated clearly with date, month, and year of joining and leaving studies.
26. Employment record details of service rendered by the applicant in different cadres clearly mentioning date, month and year of appointment, scale of pay and pay drawn. The period of study during the service should be indicated clearly with proof.
27. Service rendered outside KVAFSU if any, should be clearly indicated with proof.
28. Applicants already employed in organizations other than KVAFSU should upload/submit service/experience certificate issued by competent authority.
29. Relaxations and concessions for SCs/STs/OBCs/PH will be applicable in accordance with reservation policy of the GOK and subsequent clarification/directives issued from time to time to this effect.
30. The eligibility of an applicant shall be determined in accordance with the KVAFSU Acts, Statutes and approved Scored cards and its subsequent amendments and/or in accordance with the relevant regulations of concerned Regulatory bodies.
31. The University shall verify the antecedents or documents submitted by a candidate at the time of appointment or during the tenure of the service. In case, it is detected that the documents submitted by the candidates are fake or the candidate has a clandestine antecedent/ background and has suppressed the said information, then his/her services shall be terminated.
32. **The University reserves the right to withdraw any advertised post(s)** at any time without giving any reason. Selected candidates will be coming under the new pension scheme as per Govt. order No. FD (SN) 04 PET 2006 Dated 31.03.2006 and as amended from time to time.
33. In case of any inadvertent mistake in the process of selection which may be detected at any stage even after the issue of appointment letter, the University reserves right to modify/withdraw/cancel the appointment without any communication made to the

candidate. However, under the extraordinary circumstances, the above conditions may be relaxed.

34. In case of any dispute/ambiguity that may occur in the process of selection, the decision of the University shall be final.
35. Selection of in-service Applicants shall be subject to the fulfillment of Government order DPAR 19 SRR 2020 dated 12-10-2020.
36. Canvassing in any form will be liable to disqualification.
37. No interim correspondence shall be entertained.
38. **Three sets of A4 size Hard Copies** of the application along with all enclosures should be submitted ***DURING ORIGINAL DOCUMENT VERIFICATION ONLY***. The post Code & Post Name should be super scribed on the envelope. Only one application should be submitted in one envelope.
39. Late and Incomplete applications are liable to be rejected and the University is not responsible for any kind of postal delay in submission.
40. The eligibility of the candidate will be determined as per the Last date of notification i.e **24.02.2023.**
