BSL-3 Laboratory and Biofermentor at IAH & VB Bangalore

This Bio-security laboratory is for handling pathogenic organisms which cause diseases to animals and to certain extents to humans Bio-security laboratory has containment facility where air is filtered water or effluents are treated with chemicals before letting into environment. Because of this treatment even though pathogenic organisms are handled in that laboratory, they will not contaminate environment and does not cause any harm to animals and humans. Very a few institution have this type of facilities in India.



On the same auspicious day our Health Minister Dr. Acharya inaugurated the Bio-fermentor for animal vaccine Production. Bio-fermentor boosts up the Production of Veterinary Biologicals (Capacity to produce 2 lak doses of vaccines) especially bacterial vaccines like Haemorrhagic septicemia, Black Quarter and Enterotoxaemia etc. Bio-fermentor Helps in achieving in large production batches, uniform and consistent quality, maintenance and easy availability of required biologicals for maintenance of animal health.

Achievements

Institute of Animal Health and Veterinary Biologicals Bangalore

a. Biological Production

Eighteen different bacterial and viral vaccines and diagnostic reagents against livestock and poultry diseases are produced in this Institute and supplied to the farmers through the Department of animal Husbandry and Veterinary Services in Karnataka.

b. Quality control

This wing has the responsibility of testing and ensuring the quality of the biological produced in the Institute. All the biological, diluents and diagnostic reagents are subjected to potency, purity and safety tests before they are released for field use. During the period under report 28 biologicals were subjected for quality control tests.

c. Research and Disease Investigation

The main objectives of this section is to provide diagnostic services to the field veterinarians and given suitable advice regarding prevention and control of contagious diseases of livestock and poultry. This section has a Central Laboratories, One each at Belgaum, Bellary, Gulbarga, Mangalore, Mysore and Davangere. A diagnostic laboratory exclusively for wild Animals is functioning at Bannerghatta National Park, Bannerghatta. These laboratories are being strengthened under SDI plan. Institute has entered into an MOU with Bangalore dairy for starting a diagnostic Laboratory at Bangalore Dairy for starting a diagnostic Laboratory at Bangalore Dairy with Technical Collaboration with the Institute. A MOU has been entered with MLE College for women, Malleshwaram, Bangalore for a collaborative research project on Leptospirosis funded by UGC.

The Project: "Coastal conservation Strategies and enterprise development of sustainable livelihood in Karnataka, India" was sanctioned by Covenant Centre for development under Ford-Foundation Project Principal Investigation in Dr. Ramachandra Bhat, and project duration will be 2 years (2006-2008).

Another Project "Assessment of returns for investment in fisheries research and education" a collaborative project with NAARM, Hyderabad had been approved for support by the ICAR. Prof. R. Muni Reddy will be the Principal Investigation.

Awards / Recognition
