2nd Convocation of the university

he 2nd Convocation of the University was held on 17th January, 2009, which is the 'Foundation Day' of the University. Shri. Revu Naik Belamagi, Hon'ble Minister for Animal Husbandry & Pro-Chancellor of the University presented the Degrees, Medals and Awards to the students in Undergraduate, Postgraduate and Doctorate studies. The Convocation address was deliverd by Dr. A. L. Chaudhary, President, Veterinary Council of India, New Delhi. In his address, he emphasized on development of professional skills to enable the graduates "to achieve more with less" should be the guiding force in their never ending voyage to professional pursuit in the chosen field.

Totally 527 candidates were awarded various degrees in Animal Husbandry & Veterinary Sciences, Dairy Science & Technology and Fisheries Science. Out of which, 375 at Bachelors level, 118 at Masters level and 34 at Doctorate level were conferred. Among the total awardees, 420 were boys and 107 were girl candidates. 'Research Grant Incentive Awards' were also awarded to teachers, who handled major outside funded projects. Prof. Suresh, S. Honnappagol, Vice-Chancellor welcomed the Hon'ble Minister, Chief Guest and other dignitaries and presented a brief report on the University achievements and accomplishments made. Dr. M.
