3rd CONVOCATION OF THE KVAFSU

The 3rd Convocation of the University was held on January 17th, 2010 at KVAFSU Campus, Nandinagar, Bidar, which is the Foundation Day of the University. Dr. S. Ayyappan, Director General, ICAR & Secretary, Department of Agriculture Research & Education, GOI, New Delhi, was the Chief Guest. Dr. S. Ayyappan is an Alumnus of the College of Fisheries, Mangalore (which is presently a constituent College of the KVAFSU) and studied his Bachelors and Masters Degree during 1970's. In his Convocation address, he appreciated the efforts of KVAFSU in imparting quality education, carrying out research and extension activities for the benefit of farming community. Focusing towards graduating students, he said "you are graduating from one of the finest Universities and I am sure the education obtained in the precincts of this University will always stand you in good stead and encourage you to serve the humanity at large and the farming community in particular". Quoting the poems by our former President of India Dr. A.P.J. Abdul Kalam, he said "as a young citizen of India, armed with technology, knowledge and love for my nation, I realize, small aim is a crime", "so I have a dream, because dream transforms into thoughts, thoughts result into action and the action results into achieving the mission". He also reminiscenced his good old student days spent at College of Fisheries, Mangalore during 1970s,
