The Karnataka Veterinary, Animal & Fisheries Sciences University (KVAFSU), Bidar, organised a "Januvaru, Kukkuta, Matsya & Krishi Mela - 2013" during March 1-3, 2013 at Veterinary College, Shivamogga. The mela was inaugurated by Dr. C. Renukaprasad, Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor, KVAFSU, Bidar. Dr. M. Devaraj, Dean, VCS, presided over the Inaugural Ceremony. Sri. M.V. Vedamurthy, Deputy Commissioner, Shivamogga was the Chief Guest. Sri. T. Mukund Varma, Dr. D.R. Nagesh and Dr. (Smt.) Vishalaxi, V. Technical Consultancy was given to the farmers different aspects of agriculture, fisheries, dairy and livestock farming. Twenty five progressive farmers shared their experiences with other farmers in Farmers-to-Farmers interaction meet.
