Dear Colleagues,

The University news letter Volume-IV, Issue-2 for the period July-December, 2008 is in your hands. The important activities organised and milestones achieved during the period have been documented in this issue. Indeed we have made sustained

progress in teaching, research and extension activities for the period, however, we all have to toil a lot to progress further.

The University has successfully completed the recruitment of teachers under backlog and is preparing for taking up direct recruitment of teachers and service personals. The dream of converting the University into virtual integrated university is being implemented in phased manner with introduction of facilities like internet, e-resource centers, video-conferencing and development of touch screen information Kiosks.

The Video conferencing facility created at the Headquarters and Bangalore Regional office are effectively being used for the regular conduct of Officers Meetings and five such meetings have been conducted effectively during the period. This has helped a lot for the effective governance reducing the distance of 750 kms between Bidar and Bangalore. To intensify the inland fisheries activities in the Upper Krishna Project area a Fisheries Research and Information Center is being launched at Almatti under the assistance of RKVY. The Hon'ble Chief Minister, Government of Karnataka has laid the foundation for this center on 07.12.2008.

Among the 7 constituent Colleges the Veterinary College, Bangalore has celebrated its Golden Jubilee year on 29.11.2008. On the eve of Golden Jubilee celebrations the college has conducted several National and International seminars on various aspects including cultural Gold Vet Fest for the benefit of students.

The University is also progressing towards attaining world class status with the initiation of mutual cooperation agreement with Japan, USA and other countries. The flow of foreign nationals seeking admissions for the Master's and Ph.D., programmes in Veterinary, Animal and Fisheries Science is steadily increasing. 
Research Project Funded
