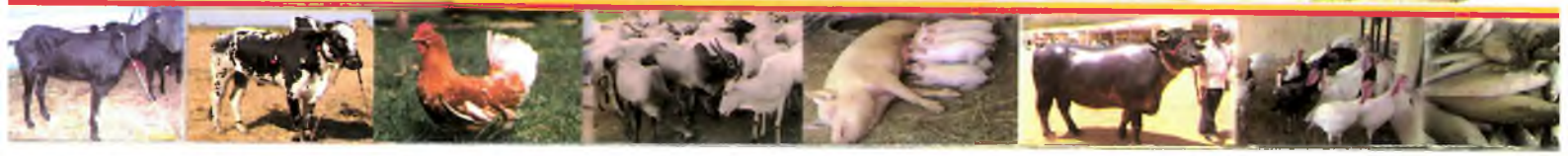
## FISH FARMER'S DAY

### National Workshop on "Development of brood bank for Amur common carp"

The three days workshop was held at Fisheries Research and Information Centre (Iniad), Hebbal, Bengaluru during 17-19th July, 2013. The workshop was sponsored by NFDB, Hyderabad as a part of ongoing project headed by Dr.Y. Basavaraju, Professor and Head, FRIC, Bengaluru. Twenty six participants from 15 states across the country participated in the workshop representing State Fisheries Departments, Research institutes and Universities. The main objective of the workshop was to sensitize the participants about the activities of brood bank of Amur, the new strain of common carp (*Cyprinus carpio*) and to discuss about the production of nuclear breeder seed and supply to different hatcheries in the country and to assess the performance of this strain of common carp for important aquaculture traits in comparison with the unselected local stocks.

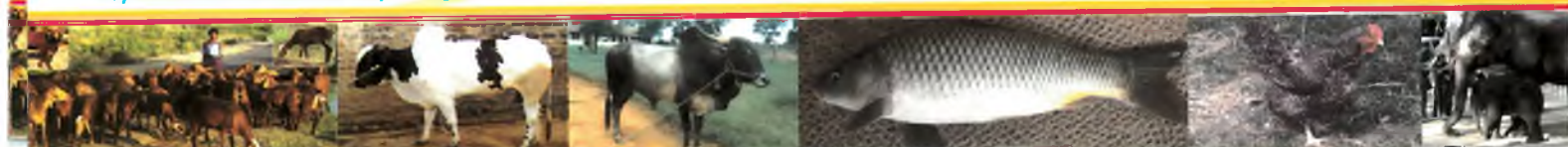

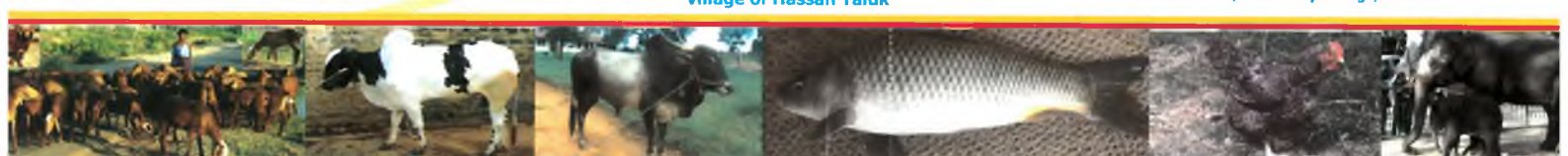
