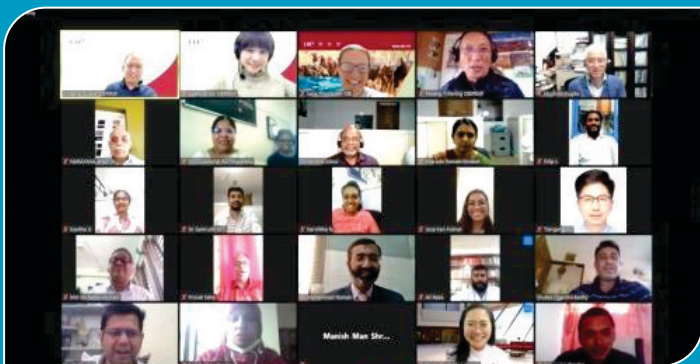
### Veterinary College, Bengaluru
