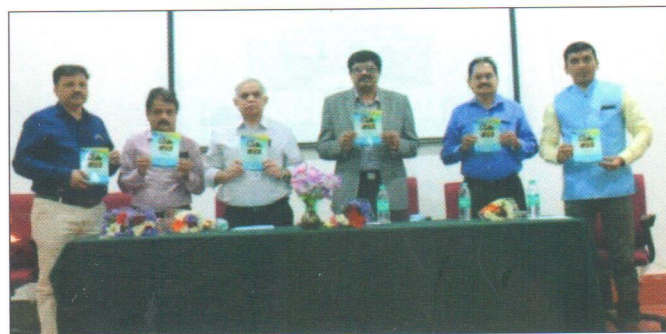
Veterinary College, Bengaluru

- The Department of Veterinary Parasitology and Centre of Advanced Faculty Training has successfully conducted 21 days National training programme on “Different approaches for control of parasitic diseases of large and small ruminants” from 20 November to 10 December, 2019. A total of 16 trainees from different parts of India have participated in the training programme.



- Workshop cum training programme was conducted on “Menace of Antimicrobial Resistance in mastitis and its remedies” on 14-16 November, 2019 organised jointly by Department of Veterinary Medicine and Department of Veterinary Microbiology with the support of KVC, Bengaluru. About 52 veterinarians of Karnataka Milk Federation and Officers of Department of Animal Husbandry and Veterinary Services participated and discussed about subclinical mastitis diagnosis and alternate medicine to combat Antimicrobial Resistance.

- Workshop cum training programme was conducted on 22 November, 2019 on “Alternate System of Medicine with special reference to Homeopathy medicine”. The programme was attended by about 39 Veterinarians of KMF from different parts of the State and subject specialists delivered talk on Diagnosis of mastitis and alternate system of medicine for the treatment.
- Department of Poultry Science conducted one week Poultry training programme sponsored by Government of India in collaboration with CPDO, Hessaragatta, Bengaluru for about 90 Poultry farmers from 19-24 August, 2019.



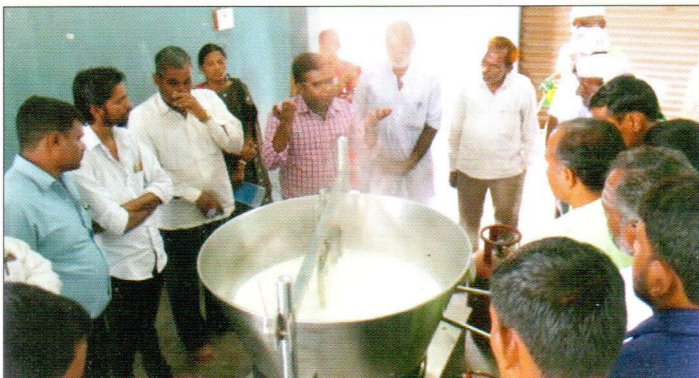
- Bhoosamruddhi Project Department of Veterinary and A.H Extension Education, Bengaluru has organised three training programmes under Bhoosamruddhi project for the farmers of Gowribidanur taluk (08 August, 13 and 31 September, 2019). A total of 126 farmers participated in the training programmes. Five demonstrations each on Dry fodder enrichment, Concentrate supplement preparation and silage

preparation using silo bags for the farmers of Gowribidanur taluk. Also three fodder nurseries were established and Artificial Insemination (AI) was carried out in sheep and goats of Siddlaghatta and Gowribidanur taluk. A field day was organised on 19 October, 2019 at Saragondlu, Gowribidanur Taluk. Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor, Prof. H.D. Narayanaswamy participated as chief guest in the field day and interacted with farmers.



Veterinary College, Bidar

- A three-day short-term training programme on “Giriraja Poultry farming” for SC-ST farmers was conducted from 08-10 August, 2019 under the SCSP/TSP grants for the year 2018-19 from the Govt. of Karnataka. A total of 30 farmers were trained in this programme.
- A two-day short-term training programme on “Clean Milk Production and Value addition of Milk Products” for dairy farmers was conducted on 30 October and 1 November, 2019 under the project “Capacity Building on Quality Milk Production and Meat Processing for Improving Rural Livelihood in Bidar District” funded by ICRISAT. A total of 45 farmers were trained on clean milk production followed by demonstration and hands on training on value addition of milk products.



- Department of Animal Husbandry and Veterinary Services, Karnataka, KVAFSU, Bidar and Extension Education Institute (EEI), Hyderabad jointly organized the training programme on “Process Documentation Skills for Extension Professionals” during 26-29 November, 2019 at Nandinagar Campus. 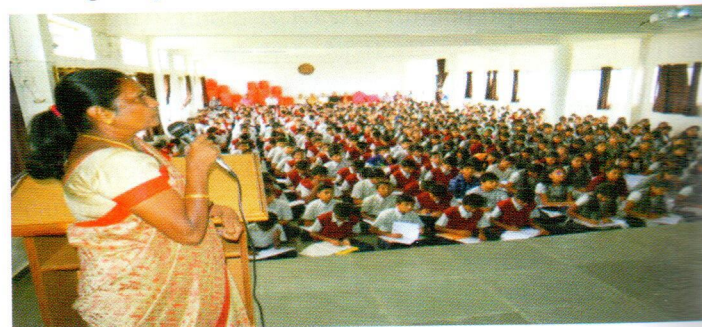
Veterinary College, Bidar

- The Inter-Collegiate KVAFSU Youth Festival “Gokulotsava 2019” was organised from 2-4 November, 2019.

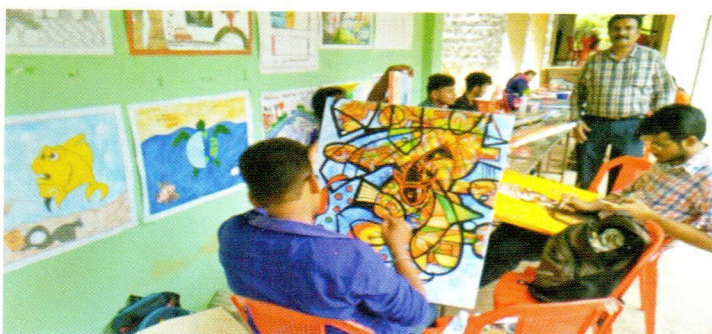


Dairy Science College, Bengaluru

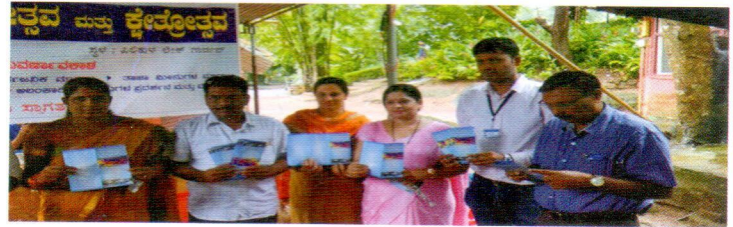

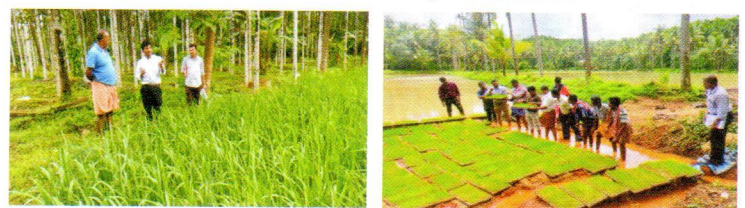
