Essential Qualifications/Requirements:

Graduate with 1-year Diploma course in computer application with one year experience in the related field.

Job Responsibilities and Duties:

1. Data entry on IDSP/IHIP and other electronic database on real time basis that is preloaded on a designated project laptop/computer.
2. To analyze demographic, clinical and laboratory data captured by the project in terms of frequencies and proportions.
3. Provide assistance for data collection, compilation, reporting and analysis and other local action pertaining to the project.
4. Assist in organizing training programmes.
5. Assist in the organization of technical meetings.
6. Assist in compilation of monthly reviews and periodic reports and plans under the project.
7. To assist in completion of any other work assigned by Programme Division, DZDP, NCDC, New Delhi.
8. To identify clustering of cases or any other important findings from the laboratory data under the supervision of Nodal Officer and its timely dissemination of the same to State and District Surveillance Officer and Entomologist – Health Department, State and District Animal Husbandry Department and other relevant stakeholders.

Essential Qualifications/Requirements:

Graduate in Medical Laboratory Technology from a recognized University/Institute/Hospital

OR

Diploma in Medical Laboratory Technology (MLT) with the course of at least 2 years duration from a recognized University.

OR

Diploma/Certificate in Medical Laboratory Technology (MLT) with the course of at least one year Duration from a recognized University.

OR

Diploma in Animal Husbandry with the course of at least 2 years duration from a recognized university

Desirable:

- 1 year experience for those of working in medical laboratory with diploma in MLT (2 year course) from recognized Central Government/State Government hospital/Institute/Autonomous/Private Institute.
- 2 years' experience in working in medical laboratory for those with diploma in MLT (1 year course) from a recognized Central Government/Delhi Government hospital/Institute/Autonomous/Private Institute.
- 1 year experience in a medical laboratory for Graduate in Science from a recognized Central Government/Delhi Government hospital/Institute/Autonomous/Private Institute.
- Candidates with work experience in "Quality assured Laboratory" shall be preferred.

Job Responsibilities and Duties:

1. Identification of eligible patients for inclusion in the sentinel surveillance in collaboration with treating physician.
2. History taking of eligible patients – After the patient's chart will be flagged for study inclusion, the laboratory technician will work with the designated clinicians to ensure proper enrolment of each eligible patient i.e. taking clinical, demographic and epidemiological details as per project's guidelines.
3. Ensure case enrolment- laboratory technician will work with the designated clinicians to ensure proper enrolment of each eligible patient.
4. Specimen collection and lab diagnosis- Appropriate Clinical samples as per protocol and the defined algorithm to be collected under supervision of treating physician.
5. Testing of clinical samples: Routine testing of clinical samples for various zoonotic diseases as per the standard operating procedures in practice at the health facility.
6. Assist in organizing training programmes under the programme.
7. Assist in the organization of technical meetings under the programme.
8. Assist in compilation of monthly reviews and periodic reports and plans under the project.
9. To participate in SLZC and DLZC along with Nodal Officer and assist in facilitation of the same.
10. Assist in completion of any other work assigned by Programme Division, DZDP, NCDC, New Delhi.
