Provide assistance for data collection, compilation, reporting and analysis and other local action pertaining to the project. Assist in organizing training programmes. Assist in the organization of technical meetings. Assist in compilation of monthly reviews and periodic reports and plans under the project. To assist in completion of any other work assigned by Programme Division, DZDP, NCDC, New Delhi. To identify clustering of cases or any other important findings from the laboratory data under the supervision of Nodal Officer and its timely dissemination of the same to State and District Surveillance Officer and Entomologist – Health Department, State and District Animal Husbandry Department and other relevant stakeholders.

Identification of eligible patients for inclusion in the sentinel surveillance in collaboration with treating physician. History taking of eligible patients – After the patient's chart will be flagged for study inclusion, the laboratory technician will work with the designated clinicians to ensure proper enrolment of each eligible patient i.e. taking clinical, demographic and epidemiological details as per project's guidelines. Ensure case enrolment- laboratory technician will work with the designated clinicians to ensure proper enrolment of each eligible patient. Specimen collection and lab diagnosis- Appropriate Clinical samples as per protocol and the defined algorithm to be collected under supervision of treating physician. Testing of clinical samples: Routine testing of clinical samples for various zoonotic diseases as per the standard operating
