1. Name of Position: Project Technical Support I (Animal Health)

3. Essential Qualifications/Requirements:

Diploma in Animal Husbandry with the course of at least 2 years duration from a recognized university

Two years of experience in activities of Animal Husbandry and Livestock handling

Candidates need to be of age less than 28 years and more than 18 years

Desirable:

- Candidates with expertise in handling of animals and collection of clinical samples from animals shall be preferred
- Knowledge on basics of computers & its application in data analysis

4. Job Responsibilities and Duties:

- Visit to identified villages in KFD endemic & non-endemic areas and collect data as per questionnaire format.
- Proper documentation of responses both hard copy & digital documents and analysis
- Blood collection from the animals and ectoparasite collection
- Specimen collection and lab diagnosis – Field visits to collect appropriate clinical samples as per the protocol under supervision of concerned Veterinarian.
- Collection, segregation and storage of samples along with processing the samples for diagnosis
- Testing of clinical samples: To assist in morphological identification of ticks/vectors
- Assist in organizing training programmes under the programme.
- Assist in the organization of technical meetings under the programme.
- Assist in compilation of monthly reviews and periodic reports and plans under the project.

- Testing of clinical samples: Routine testing of clinical samples for various zoonotic diseases as per the standard operating procedures in practice at the health facility.
