## KVAFSU, BIDAR -THE HOST UNIVERSITY

Realizing a two-decade lag in the development of animal husbandry, dairy, and fisheries under existing agricultural universities, the Government of Karnataka established the Karnataka Veterinary, Animal and Fisheries Sciences University (KVAFSU) through the Karnataka Act No. 9 of 2004. The Act was published in the Karnataka Gazette Extraordinary on 23<sup>rd</sup> February 2004. KVAFSU was created with a focused mandate to promote education, research, and extension in veterinary, animal, dairy, and fisheries sciences across the state. Its logo, inscribed with the motto "Farmers Friendly and Rural Oriented", reflects its commitment to the farming community.

KVAFSU functions autonomously under its Board of Management, which governs the university as per the Act and statutes. The Finance Committee, Academic Council, Board of Studies, Research Council, and Extension Education Council manage finances, academics, research, and extension activities respectively.

The University aims to provide quality higher education in veterinary, animal, and fisheries sciences; promote advanced research in these and allied sciences; extend specialized knowledge and technologies to rural farmers; and undertake other objectives as may be notified by the State Government from time to time.

KVAFSU aims to lead in teaching, research, and extension, embracing emerging scientific paradigms to build skilled human resources and innovative technologies for the benefit of the livestock and fisheries sectors.

## DEPARTMENT OF VETERINARY PHARMACOLOGY AND TOXICOLOGY

The host Department is well recognized for its scientific contribution towards bioprospecting of indigenous biomolecules as well as repurposing of existing pharmacophores. The Department was established in the year 2007 and as of now 16 batches of the UG students completed the degree. A total of 16 M.V.Sc students have been awarded with M.V.Sc degree. Department is actively involved in organizing conferences/seminars/training-cum-workshop since its inception.

Faculties and students of the department have the credential to achieve prestigious awards from ICAR, DBT, CSIR and Different National Academies and Societies.

This year we are organizing this mega event of 25th Annual Conference of Indian Society of Veterinary Pharmacology and Toxicology. The Department had handled more than 12 extramural research projects from different national and international funding agencies worth of Rs:15 crores and developed the state of art equipment facilities.

#### **SHIVAMOGGA**

Shivamogga, often called the "Gateway to the Malnad," is a culturally rich city in Karnataka located on the banks of the Tunga River. Historically, it was part of the Keladi Nayaka kingdom, which played a key role during the post-Vijayanagara period. The city is known for its lush greenery, heritage, and contribution to Kannada literature and education. The city's central location and growing infrastructure make it easily accessible from various regions of South India and beyond.

Nearby attractions include Jog Falls, one of India's highest waterfalls, formed by the Sharavathi River. Keladi, just 8 km from Sagar, holds the historical Keladi Fort and Rameshwara Temple with exquisite Dravidian architecture. Agumbe, known as the "Cherrapunji of the South," is famous for sunsets and rainforest ecology. Ikkeri, with its Aghoreshwara Temple, is another notable site of Nayaka-era architecture. Sakrebailu Elephant Camp, located on the outskirts of Shivamogga, offers a unique experience in observing and interacting with elephants in a natural setting.



#### **HOW TO REACH SHIVAMOGGA?**

Shivamogga is well-connected to major cities of India by road, rail and air.

By Road: Shivamogga lies about 315 km from Bengaluru and is connected via NH-69. Regular KSRTC and private buses operate from Bengaluru, Mangaluru, Hubballi, and Mysuru.

By Train: Shivamogga Town Railway Station (SMET) is the main station. It is connected to Bengaluru, Mysuru, Hubballi and Chennai with daily trains like the Intercity Express and Jan Shatabdi apart from other 4 trains.

By Air: The newly operational Shivamogga Domestic Airport (RQY) offers direct flights to Bengaluru and is expected to expand connectivity. Alternatively, Mangaluru (200 km) and Bengaluru (300 km) airports serve as major international gateways with road or rail links to Shivamogga.



The abstract should be limited to 250 words (A4 size paper. Times New Roman, 12 font size, 1.5" space). The abstract should have the title, name of the authors (Last Name/Surname followed by initials), and institute address with the email address of presenting author (underline the name of presenting author). The abstract should consist briefly the Background, Objective, Methodology, Findings, Discussion and Conclusion but without headings. Please specify the technical session and mode of presentation i.e. Oral or Poster. For poster presentation, the poster must be in "Portrait Mode" with standard size of 3 x 2 ft. Please send abstract in MS Word as an attachment with Google Form for registration. The abstracts accompanied with proof of payment of the registration fee by the presenting author and submitted before the submission deadline will be considered for acceptance and publication. The Deadline of Abstract submission will be 30th September, 2025.
