3. **Essential Qualifications/Requirements:**

Diploma (DMLT/Animal Husbandry) of 2 years duration from a recognized Institution or Bachelor Degree in Science of 3 years duration

Candidates need to be of age less than 28 years and more than 18 years (Relaxation of Age as per ICMR Norms)

**Desirable:**

- Two years of experience for Diploma candidates and one year for Bachelor degree holders
- Candidates with expertise in data collection, handling of animals and collection of clinical samples from animals shall be preferred
- Knowledge on basics of computers & its application in data analysis

4. **Job Responsibilities and Duties:**

- Visit to identified villages in KFD endemic & non-endemic areas and collect data as per questionnaire format.
- Proper documentation of responses both hard copy & digital documents and analysis
- Blood collection from the animals and ecto-parasite collection with the help of Veterinarians
- Specimen collection and lab diagnosis – Field visits to collect appropriate clinical samples as per the protocol under supervision of concerned Veterinarian.
- Collection, segregation & storage of samples along with processing for diagnosis
- Testing of clinical samples: To assist in morphological identification of ticks/vectors
- Assist in organizing training programmes under the programme.
- Assist in the organization of technical meetings under the programme.
- Assist in compilation of monthly reviews and periodic reports and plans under the project.
- Assist in completion of any other work assigned by PI
